Youth events are designed to:

 - *teach safety, and*
- *encourage development of advanced skiing skills.*

YOUTH ARE REQUIRED TO RSVP BY THE MONDAY BEFORE THE EVENT.

Youth Program Rules:

- Youth ages 4 to 17 are eligible to participate, additional fees may apply to those under 7.
- Youth must pay youth dues or be part of a Club Family Membership, to be eligible for youth benefits.
- Parents or guardians are required to sign a Liability Waiver and Emergency Contact Form prior to youth participation.
- Parents or guardians are to chaperon their youth at activities.
- Youth benefits may include lift tickets and lesson, unless stated otherwise. Lessons availability could be limited and offered on a 1st come 1st served basis, if a sufficient number of instructors are not present. Those that RSVP get would be offered lessons 1st.
- Transportation, meals, ski rental, helmets, ski wee (tots), etc. fees not included. Use of helmets is recommended. Those with special diets are advised to bring their own meals.
- Youth may be reimbursed for limited skiing development related expenses through pre-authorization by the Chair, such as the youth budget allows.
- Youth are required to RSVP and arrive as schedule, in order to participate.
